Unless you can provide documentary evidence that the City complied with the other requirements of the Brown Act, namely the posting of the agenda at the hotel and the accessibility of devices for public participation we can only conclude the City Council ignored its responsibilities for Brown Act compliance and WECA may seek judicial intervention to declare the entire meeting in violation of the Brown Act.

WECA looks forward to your prompt resolution of this violation.
